**FIRST SEMESTER INCOMING FRESHMAN Online Registration for Academic Courses**

Shaw University offers easy online registration for current semester coursework to students that meet mandatory academic requirements. The following criterion has been established to meet standards of eligibility:

- Use a Confidential Student ID number from Admissions Office and a Confidential Personal Identification Number (PIN) from the Registrar's Office to access online Registration and Blackboard, and
- Advisement of required discipline coursework and approval from the assigned Faculty Advisor, Departmental Chairpersons. Students with Undeclared/Undecided Majors **must contact** the Director, Academic Advising Center at (919) 582-3760/4978

**Coursework Add/Drop (Course Registration Procedures)**

The Shaw University website has been enhanced to ensure proficiency and interaction from current and perspective students. Currently enrolled students can easily access academic information, register for courses, view financial aid and account information, and view mandatory academic deadlines. Students will also be allowed to add and drop coursework. To access this site, **TYPE** the following URL: <http://artemis.shawu.edu/ics>.

**OR** GO to the bottom right side of the Shaw University Home Page and **CLICK** on **Register Online (Bears Portal)** to bring up the screen: *“Welcome to Bears Portal Online Registration and Academic Advising System”*.

**CLICK ON:** <http://artemis.shawu.edu/ics>. *See section (“Coursework Add (Course Registration)”)*

The Portal web page will appear that provides information on upcoming campus and community events.

1. **ENTER/TYPE** current student **Username** (Student ID number) and **Password** (Personal Identification Number/(PIN)) on the top of the web page.
2. **CLICK** on **Login**. *Additional tabs will appear on the top of the web page.*
3. Click on the **Students** Tab at the top of the page to access the Student home page. *The left-hand column on this page provides a list of helpful links that include academic information, announcements, activities calendar and other links.*

*Prior to registering for courses for an upcoming semester, students are required to meet with their Academic Advisors to review progress in their degree program, and determine required coursework towards completing their program.*

4. On the left side of the screen, **CLICK** on **Advising and Registration Information**.
5. On the right side of the screen, **CLICK** on **Add/Drop Courses**

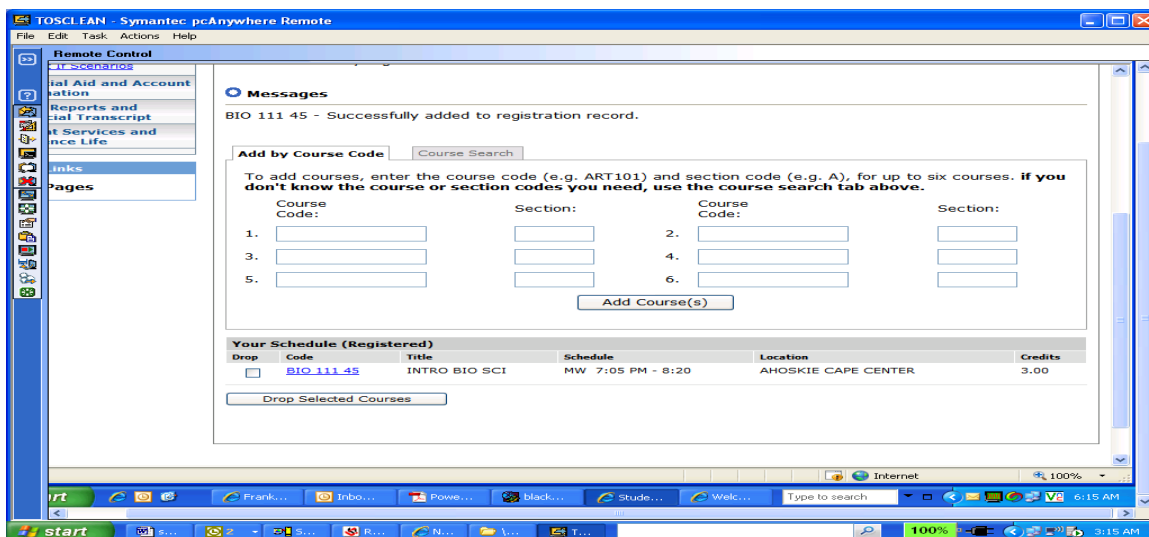
Make sure the appropriate Term is showing e.g. fall semester 2008. Select, using the down arrow or Type the appropriate division: e.g. ALL for all Students, Undergraduate for Undergraduate Students and Graduate for Graduate Students

6. **CLICK on Course Search** in the middle of the page.
7. **CLICK** on the down arrow on the right side of **Department** (in the middle of the page)  
*Choose a course Title from your Academic Advisement Form*
8. **CLICK** on the down arrow on the right side of **Division** and **CHOOSE Undergraduate** if you are an Undergraduate Student and **Graduate** if you are a Graduate student.
9. **CLICK** on **Search** at the bottom
10. **To choose a course for the semester, CLICK** on the **Add** button on the left side of the desired course and then **CLICK the Add Courses** tab at the bottom of the screen.

If you are not able to add, please check with the Registrar's Office at (919 546-8415.

*Raleigh Day students should register courses with sections 1-19 only while Cape students should contact their respective Cape Directors for the appropriate sections of their Cape Centers*

*If there are no pre-requisites not met for the course, a successful registration message will be sent and the course will appear on your schedule as seen in the window below.*



11. **Repeat # 5 - #10** to complete your course selection.

**UNDERGRADUATES MUST REGISTER FOR A MINIMUM OF 12 CREDIT HOURS FOR FULL TIME STATUS.**

12. To drop a course, **CLICK** the **Drop** Tab on the left-hand side of the course and **CLICK** the **Drop Selected Courses** Tab. A message will appear that the course has been successfully dropped.

13. Once you **COMPLETE** your **Registration**, **PRINT** your **Schedule** according to the following instructions:

- a) **CLICK** on the **Course Schedule** (on the left side of the screen/page)
- b) **CLICK** on **Printer Friendly** at the top right side of the page/screen
- c) **CLICK** on **Send to Printer** on the left side of the page/screen

14. **LOGOUT** of the **System**.

The Major Exploration and What If Scenarios window will give/allow the opportunity to play “What if I Change My Major” game to see how courses apply to various majors.

The financial aid and account information page provides a view of financial aid awards, list of requirements per student of documentation and steps to make on-line payments. To pay bill online, click on the **How to Pay My Bill Online** Tab in the window on the right-hand side of this page.

The Student Services and Residence Life page will allow view of information pertaining to residence life at Shaw University. Helpful links also appear on this page and the page provides access to additional valuable information on other websites.
